

Lake Harriet Yacht Club

Membership Information

The Lake Harriet Yacht Club is a non-profit corporation formed in 1947 to promote sailboat racing on Lake Harriet. Currently the Club conducts races for MC, M Scows, Optimists and Open class boats.

Races are held from May through September on Wednesday evenings, Saturday afternoons, Sunday mornings, and Holiday mornings. Other Club activities include a spring and a fall regatta, two women's sailing clinics, and racing seminars including instructional racing for beginner racers on Saturday mornings in June. The Club also sponsors year-round social events.

Club membership options are explained below:

Family Membership

All adults and children in the household are members of the Club. A Family Membership has one vote at Club business meetings, and the vote may be cast by any member of the household who is age 16 or older. This is the option to choose if you expect that more than one household member will participate in Club activities, including racing as skipper or crew. It is also the option to choose if your child will be racing an Optimist on Wednesday nights. Family Members who crew are not required to pay crew dues.

Individual Membership

This option is for persons age 16 and older who are single or who expect that no other household members will participate in Club activities. An Individual Membership has one vote at Club business meetings, and the vote must be cast by the Individual Member.

Junior Membership

Sailors under the age of 16 whose families are not members may choose a Junior Membership. Junior Members may skipper an X-Boat and may crew on any boat in Club races. Junior Members may not vote or hold office in the Club.

Crew/Social Membership

This membership is for those over the age of 16 who intend to crew during Club races. A Crew Membership is also a Social Membership, entitling one to receive all Club mailings and attend all Club social events. Crew Members may skipper a boat in Club races, but the boat will not be scored. Crew Members may attend the Club business meetings, but they may not vote or hold office in the Club. Any person who crews for more than 3 races must be a member of the club.

Racing Fees

Family, Individual, and Junior Members must pay a racing fee for their boat to be scored in Club races. The racing fee covers the cost of conducting races and awarding trophies. If a Member owns more than one boat, the Member must pay a full racing fee for the first boat and a half fee for each additional boat to be scored. If co-owners of a boat wish to be scored separately, each co-owner must pay the co-owner racing fee as indicated on the Membership Form. If co-owners do not want to be scored separately, only one full racing fee should be paid and should be sent in full by one of the co-owners. Contact the Club Treasurer if you are uncertain as to which racing fee to pay.

Half Season Discount

All membership dues and racing fees are reduced by 50% after the July 4th Race Series.
