Trophy age requirements must be met before the first scheduled race. (MC skippers pay your MCSA dues via credit card and save \$5 off entry fee.)

Rules: The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 as adopted and amended by US SAILING, MCSA Sailing Instructions and the Local Appendix will govern races. A boat entering as a member of a class must conform to class rules.

Scoring: Low-Point, as outlined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing
